Configure Uncontrolled Risk on Print

It is understood that, for some organisations, it is not desirable to print uncontrolled risk levels as they will not apply if the user is following the assessment's controls properly.

While the default for Sypol will be to continue printing uncontrolled risk, both for new and existing subscribers, subscribers can now configure Sypol so that uncontrolled risk is never printed for any of their users and any of their assessments.

Printing uncontrolled risk can be configured using the *manager* account, by setting the *Print uncontrolled risk?* question in *Subscription Options* appropriately.



Figure 1: Setting Print Uncontrolled Risk

By setting the value to Yes, uncontrolled risk will continue to appear on printed risk assessments.

Setting the value to *No*, will prevent uncontrolled risk being printed in the assessment. The user interface will continue to display uncontrolled risk, however. This setting is applied to all users and

Please note that EcoOnline believes that best practice is for uncontrolled risk to be displayed so that anyone carrying out the task is fully aware of the importance of putting the controls in place. Therefore, the default configuration of Sypol will continue to print uncontrolled risk.

Any subscriber changing this setting so that uncontrolled risk is no longer printed does so accepting responsibility for any consequences that action may have.

Update REACH Links to UK

The REACH Management Reports page has been updated so that they now point to the UK Health & Safety Executive's external REACH pages. This replaces the previous links to the ECHA REACH pages.

The language on Sypol's REACH reports has been updated to reflect this shift to UK REACH. Some basic style changes have also been made to make the pages' appearance be more consistent with the rest of Sypol.




Figure 2: Updated REACH Management Reports Pages

Bug Fixes

- · Removing Assessment from pending can sometimes lose assessment details.
- Unable to transfer user from Significantly Changed report in To Do.
- Deeplink URLs don't work if assessment belongs to work area with lowercased name.
- · Unarchive work area option appears when work area already archived.
- · Batch printing assessments in portrait mode errors.
- Worker sheet does not print for multi-task assessments.
- Entering a phone number greater than 15 characters causes error when creating assessment.

Known Issues

- Work area filters don't show sub work areas.
- · Saving changes to manager pages redirects to the wrong page.
- · Logging in to supervisor account through the side menu can redirect to the error page.
